Mr. Nieschwietz stated that as we get into the new fiscal year the interest will catch up and surpass the costs and the financial reports will be more reflective of the earnings on the CD's. He also stated that we currently have \$13,000.00 in actual accrued interest. Mr. Nieschwietz said that he is willing to come to give this report once a year around this time to summarize the accounts and to answer any questions.

## Approval of Nueces River Authority Invoice for Educational Services:

Director Savage made the motion to approve the Nueces River Authority Invoice for the amount of \$20,000.00. Director Troell seconded the motion and there being no further discussion the motion carried unanimously.

## Discussion/Possible Action on Setting a Fee for the EUWCD to Provide Downhole Camera Services:

Director Savage made the motion to set a downhole camera service fee of \$225.00 and the fee may be waived at the General Manager's discretion. Director Peeler seconded the motion and there being no further discussion the motion carried unanimously.

## Exempt Well Registrations:

General Manager, Russell Labus said that there were exempt well registrations that came in but that he did not have time to put together a report.

## • Monitor Well Report and Water Sampling Activity:

Field Technician, Matt Pope said that his monitor well levels are 1-3 feet lower than last year but the levels are rebounding and the wells in the ASR area are looking good. Mr. Pope stated that he looks forward to using the downhole camera on one of his Frio County monitor wells. Mr. Pope said that he took two Tier 2 kits to San Antonio River Authority for lab testing and soon will be taking a water sample from a well in Frio County.

Assistant Manager, Chris McFarlane said that his monitor well levels are seasonably down 2-3 feet which is in line with previous year's levels.

#### • Other District Activities:

Assistant Manager, Chris McFarlane gave an update on the City of Kenedy test well. Mr. McFarlane stated that the test ran for 48 hours and started on November 8, 2017 at 1:05 p.m. and ended November 10, 2017 at 1:05 p.m. Mr. McFarlane said that the Test Well started at 60 gpm and stabilized at 29 gpm and within 24 hours saw substantial drawdown on the nearby PVC well. Mr. McFarlane said there were six transducers that were installed around the test well area and once the test was done they were left in for another week and a half and he is currently still processing data from the transducers.
